1. What does Lisa like best about her job?

Every day is different

2. What is a food stylist?

A food stylist works as part of a team in a commercial food studio to shoot food photographs usually to sell something (cookbooks, a food product, TV commercials or food segments on TV)

3. What are some tools used by a food stylist?

Cooking tools, brushes, palette knives, spoons, scissors, tweezers, eye droppers, pins, cotton swabs

4. What does Lisa least like about her job?

The amount of carrying she has to do – having carloads of dishes, food, and equipment she has to put away

5. What is an average day for Lisa?

Grocery shopping between 6-7 in the morning, hauling groceries into the studio, getting organized, talk to props stylist, photographer, and art director, unpack groceries, cook all day

6. How long is Lisa's workday?

Between 9-10 hours, or 14-16 hours for a TV commercial

7. What type of education is needed to be a food stylist?

There is no set educational background. Food stylists have backgrounds in nutrition, food science, graphic design or culinary.

8. How much can a food stylist earn?

An assistant = \$250-\$350/day

Average = \$650-\$750/day

With experience = up to \$1200/day

9. What is something that people don't know about food styling?

Food stylists work with real food – nothing is fake or artificial

10. What would Lisa like to change about her job?

Would like to have a little more input into the final production – would save clients money if they asked her opinion before starting a job
