1. *Find the client via advertising, networking, or referrals*
2. *Determine client needs and desires*
3. *Determine space or budget challenges*
4. *Determine remodel mandates – what must change, can't change, or should change*
5. *Determine budget for materials and services*
6. *Select the largest design element first and build on it*
7. *Select materials and hardware*
8. *Client presentation*
9. *Client feedback*
10. *Make modifications as necessary*
11. *Answer all client questions*
12. *Confirm client approval*
13. *Installation with modifications as necessary*

1. When determining what are a client’s needs and wants, what questions would you ask?

Answers will vary – sample questions:

What do you want the space to look like?

What do you want the end results to be?

What doesn’t work with the current space?

2. What were some challenges with the bathroom remodel?

The plumbing locations couldn’t be changed, not replacing the tub, the “L” shape of the bathroom, no recess in the shower due to plumbing in the way, no body sprays due to budget

3. What two ways are interior designers paid? How do they differ?

Hourly and flat rate.

Hourly rates range from \$80-\$200/hour and must estimate hours for the budget.

Flat rate usually used when working with contractors and don’t have to account for hours.

4. What is the difference between an interior designer and an interior decorator?

Education and design flair. Designers are more technical and experienced.
