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Traditional	<p>TRADITIONAL • 1700-1900</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Elegant and refined • Dark, intricately carved wood furniture and moldings • Balance and symmetry give a formal feeling • Jewel tones • Rich fabrics, including silks, brocades, satins, and needlepoint
Victorian Era	<p>VICTORIAN ERA • 1837-1901</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Excessive embellishment • Heavy proportions • Dark woods • Bronze and marble accents • Inlaid glass tables with ornate finishes • Furniture upholstered in silk brocade fabrics • Inlays with gold gilding • Patterned wall coverings, wallpapered ceilings • Claw foot tubs in bathrooms <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fabric canopies on beds to keep heat in • Wing-backed chairs that helped hold in heat from the fireplace
Mission	<p>MISSION • LATE 1800S</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Craftsmanship – oak and cherry furniture with exposed frame, light stains and clear finishes • Exposed joinery (mortise and tenant) • Embellishments were nature-inspired with trees, leaves, and branches as small inlays, rug designs or stained glass • Frank Lloyd Wright famous architect, furniture designer, and stained glass designer

Art Deco/Nouveau	<p>ART DECO/NOUVEAU • 1920-1939</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Geometric shapes • Purely decorative • Lacquer and wood inlays • Sinuous, natural curves and not a lot of sharp ends 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Metal – stainless steel and copper in furniture and wall displays and panels • Mixed materials
Retro Style	<p>RETRO STYLE • 1950 – 1975</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Simple, straight lines • Practical • Unstained wood is common • Furniture from a previous time • Often use a lot of color 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Starburst clocks and mirrors • Armless sofas
African Influence	<p>AFRICAN INFLUENCE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Animal fabrics • Hand-carved furniture, often from one piece of wood • Masks • One-of-a-kind items 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Zebra rugs and handmade woven rugs • Woven rugs as upholstery on furniture
Asian Influence	<p>ASIAN INFLUENCE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black lacquer furniture • Natural fibers/materials • Balance and symmetry • Lanterns, fans, screens, calligraphy • Simple, clean lines and uncluttered • Shoji screens 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Feng shui – the principle of how energy flows through a space • Tatami (natural grass) mats used as flooring • Hand-drawn Chinoiserie cabinets that tell a story from one panel to the next • Indoor water gardens
Southwestern	<p>SOUTHWESTERN</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pastel desert colors from sand and sunsets • Spanish ironwork • Adobe and clay • Lots of leather • Stucco or rough textured plaster walls 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Curved fireplaces • Furniture and cushions covered in homespun rugs • Rugs and mounted animals hung on walls as artwork
Shabby Chic	<p>SHABBY CHIC</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Previously owned items • Comfortable furniture, over-stuffed, casual feeling • Mix antiques with kitsch • Anything goes 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Old sofas slip covered • Furniture painted-over, scrubbed through, and chipped • Crystal chandeliers mix traditional and casual
Country	<p>COUNTRY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Early American/pioneer • Red, white, and blue checks • Oversized furniture • Distressed, natural wood • Display collectibles 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pairs floral prints with checks • Farmhouse table distressed and worn naturally over time • Patchwork quilt hung on walls
Contemporary	<p>CONTEMPORARY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimalism • Sparse/austere • Solid color accents • Clean, white background accented with pops of bright color 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Glass, metal, wood combined • Geometric shapes mixed with curves
